

LIMITED WARRANTY FOR NEW DUTCH INDUSTRIES BIO SPREADER

- A. **GENERAL PROVISIONS** - This 3 year consumer, 1 year commercial/rental warranty covers all Dutch Industries materials and workmanship free of any defects or failures. Warranty service must be performed by a dealer or service center authorized by Dutch Industries to sell and/or service the type of equipment involved, which will use only new or remanufactured parts or components furnished by Dutch Industries. Warranty service will be performed without charge to the purchaser for parts or labour. The purchaser will be responsible, however, for any service call and/or transportation of product to and from the dealer's or service center's place of business, for any premium charged for overtime labour requested by the purchaser, and for any service and/or maintenance not directly related to any defect covered under the warranties below. These warranties are transferable, provided an authorized Dutch Industries dealer is notified of the ownership change, and Dutch Industries approves the transfer.
- B. **WHAT IS WARRANTED** - Defects arising under normal use. All parts of any new Dutch Industries Bio Spreader are warranted for the number of years specified above.

We will extend warranty from the original manufacturer for all parts that are not manufactured by Dutch Industries. These parts include bearings, 3-1 gearbox, apron chain gearbox, hydraulic motor, hydraulic rams, hydraulic hoses and components, rims, tires and axle stubs.

- C. **WHAT IS NOT WARRANTED** - DUTCH INDUSTRIES IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FOLLOWING:
- (1) Normal wear and tear items including but not limited to auger teeth, slats, powder take off components, bushings, apron seals and any item Dutch Industries judges as wear items.
 - (2) Components that have been altered or modified in ways not improved by Dutch Industries.
 - (3) Failures resulting from misuse, neglect and acts of nature or accident.
- D. **CLAIMING WARRANTY** - To secure warranty service, the purchaser must (1) Report defect to an authorized dealer who will contact Dutch Industries, (2) Present evidence of the warranty start date and, (3) Make the machine available to a Dutch authorized inspector to evaluate validity of claim. No decisions on validity or extent of warranty can be made without the consent of Dutch Industries.

Dutch Industries warranty registration form needs to be submitted no longer than 30 days from time of purchase. Warranty will commence on the date of purchase unless no warranty form has been submitted, then warranty will commence on the dealer purchase date from Dutch Industries.
